- Advisors by major for all departments, by alpha for the School of Art
- Advisors stay with you for your entire degree
- Best first points of contact for:
 - Understanding your **degree audit** and progression of your degree
 - **Challenges** beyond the subject matter of your courses and connection to **services**
 - Considering a minor, double major, study abroad or an accelerated master's
 - Understanding college and university **policy**
 - Connecting to major-related **extracurriculars**
