Our office of academic advisors serve students who are:

- Undeclared;
- Undecided; and/or
- Still exploring

We work with Exploratory students to support and guide them with their academic goals and career aspirations. Our intention is for students to create their own Mason story while exploring all the possible major options that align with their interests.

### Academic Advising in Exploratory

Our office of academic advisors supports students by :

- Assisting with course scheduling and degree planning
- Helping students align their personal, academic, and career goals
- Providing personalized guidance during major exploration
- Assisting students with the major declaration process
- Ensuring awareness of Mason's timeline to declare (e.g., 60 credits)


### Virtual Advising & Registration

### Your Next Steps

#### For Freshmen:

- Review sample 4-year plans for your major of choice
- Prepare a list of AP/IB, dual-enrollment, or any other college-level credits earned, if applicable, and make sure any test scores have been sent to the Office of Admissions
- Use Patriot Web to complete a rough draft of your schedule
- Identify at least three questions to ask during virtual advising

#### For Transfers:

- Review your Transfer Credit Evaluation for any missing credits
- Ensure your **final** transcript is submitted to the Office of Admissions
- Review your degree audit to see how your transfer credits are applying to requirements
- Identify at least three questions to ask during virtual advising
