- Create connections






Key Advising Tools – first semester and beyond

- Utilize your Degree Evaluation regularly

- Scheduling appointments with your advisor or the career services office

Your Next Steps

For Freshmen:

- Review sample 4-year plans for your major of choice
- Prepare a list of AP/IB, dual-enrollment, or any other college-level credits earned, if applicable, and make sure any test scores have been sent to the Office of Admissions
- ☐ Use Patriot Web to complete a rough draft of your schedule
- ☐ Identify at least three questions to ask during virtual advising

For Transfers:

- Review your Transfer Credit Evaluation for any missing credits
- ☐ Ensure your **final** transcript is submitted to the Office of Admissions
- Review your degree audit to see how your transfer credits are applying to requirements
- ☐ Identify at least three questions to ask during virtual advising





Key Terms to Know

When we say	We mean
Mason Core	The general education courses required for your degree.
Academic Advisor	Your primary contact for all questions related to your degree!
Success Coach	Your contact for support during your transition and identifying resources; coaches do not do academic advising
Mason Degree Audit	An advising tool in Patriot Web that tracks what you have left to complete for your degree; used by you and your advisor!
Office Hours	Time your professors have set aside to meet (in person or virtually) with you!
Add / Drop / Withdraw Deadlines	Key dates for when you can make changes to your schedule during a semester
"Contact Financial Aid"	Not everyone can see your student account or advise on your funding options (loans and scholarships); Financial Aid counselors are your best contact!
Federal Work Study	A financial aid option that includes gaining work experience on campus
