

Preparing for Move-In

- Move-In Day based on resident's building.
- Detailed information available on the website and via newsletters sent out in July.
- Residents should label EVERYTHING with their name, building and room number.
- Renter's insurance is strongly recommended.







New Student Check-In

Preparing for Move-In

- Weather is usually hot, so dress comfortably.
- Determine who will help the resident get setup.
- Discuss who will be bringing large items with roommate.
- Discuss time you will be arriving and moving in with roommate.
 - They may have family members assisting them, too.

During Move-In

- Only residents allowed in check-in area.
 - Families will wait in the lobby.
- Residents will receive one unloading pass per car with belongings.
- Moving assistance is provided, but may need to wait
- After unloading, cars will relocate to long term parking.
- Shuttles provided to residential areas.
