



Studying two majors at same time.






Explains what a course is about

✓ **DROP ANY CLASS  
YOU DON'T PLAN TO TAKE**

Classes are NOT dropped for non-payment or not attending.

✓ **STUDY ELSEWHERE  
PERMISSION REQUIRED**

Must get permission in advance to take a class at another school.

✓ **READ EMAIL!**

Important to read Mason email daily and clear out spam mail regularly.

✓ **FERPA**

Right to Academic Privacy





