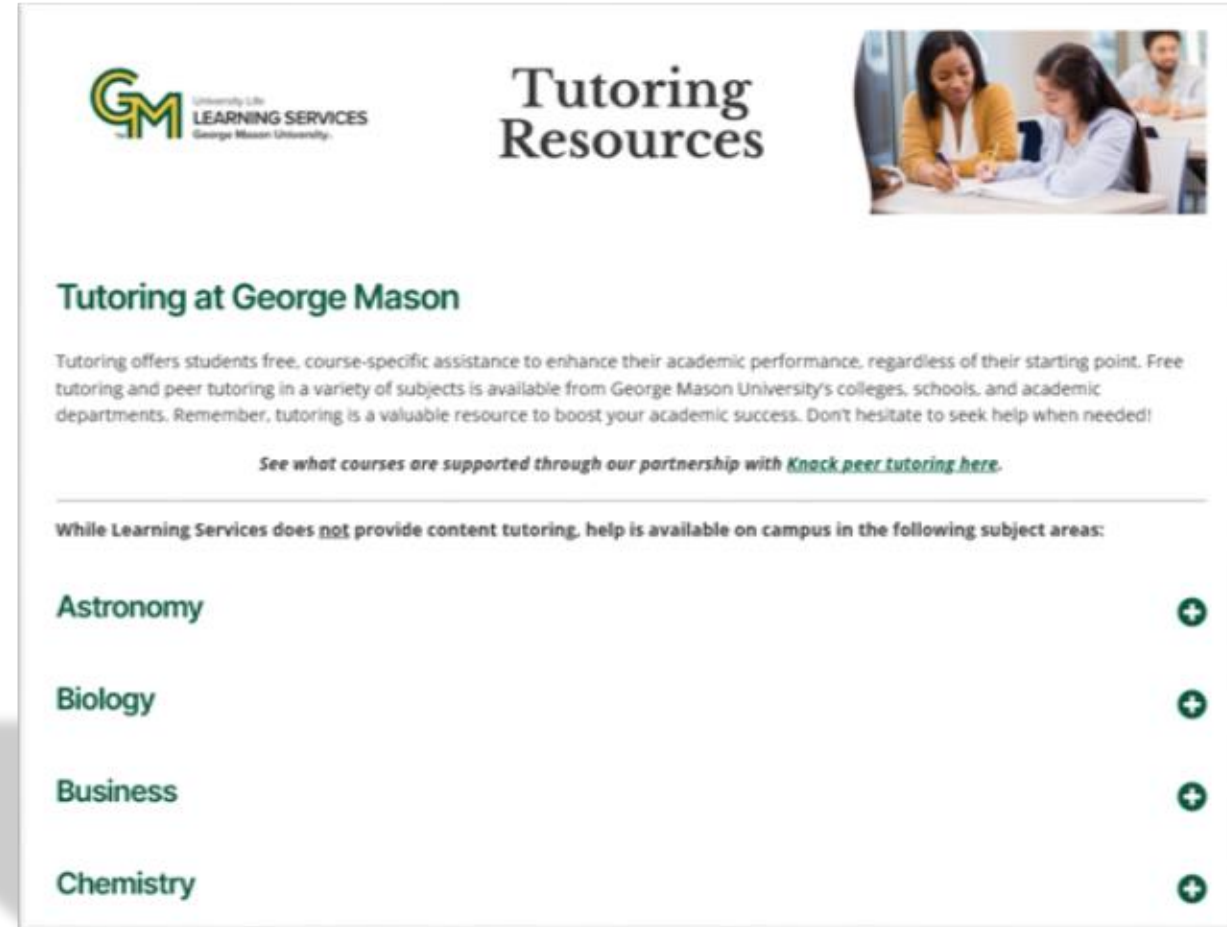

- **Lab** – place to apply concepts learned in class by conducting experiments and creating lab reports.



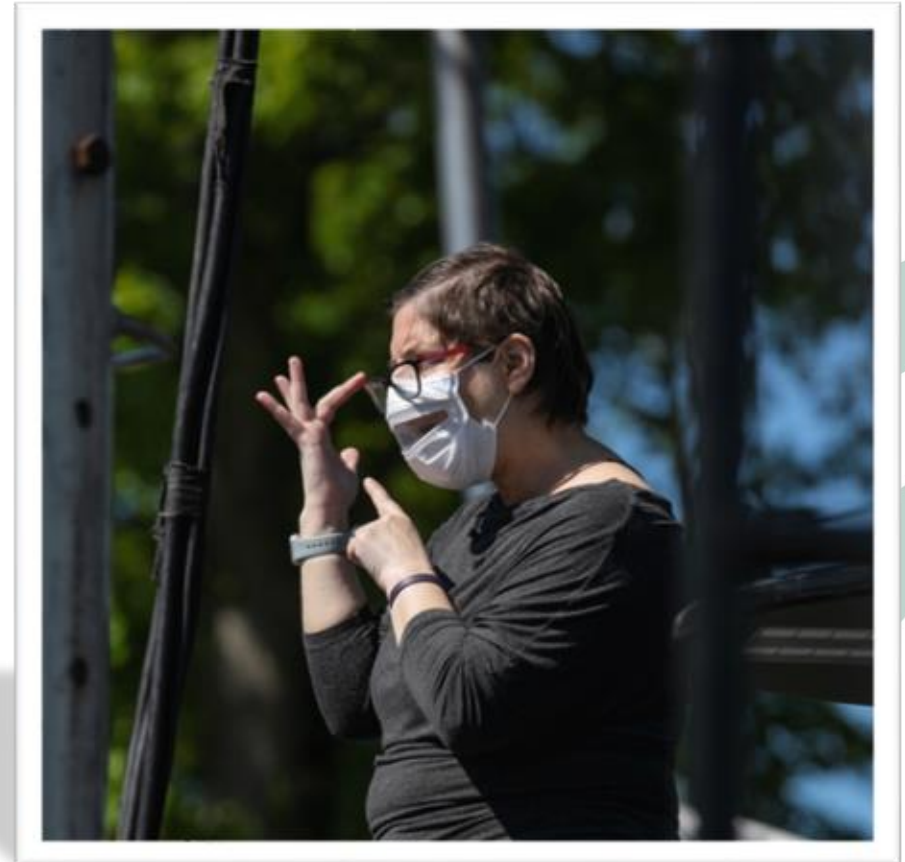
